

Fundraising Ideas

Send an email with a link to your fundraising page.

Host a poker tournament or casino night. Ask people to pay to play, or to donate their winnings to Clearbrook.

Post the link to your fundraising page on social media - Twitter, Facebook, Instagram. Be sure to tell people why Clearbrook is important to you!

Host a golf or bowling tournament. Donate the entry fees to Clearbrook.

Lead by example and make a donation yourself.

Ask a chef to host a cooking class or prepare a special dinner. Donate the admission fee to Clearbrook.

Set out a donation box at your place of business or at a local restaurant.

Host a wine or beer tasting. Get the alcohol donated and ask for donations of those who attend.

Recruit friends and family to join you for the event, and ask them to fundraise, too!

Host a bar party. You can get a reduced price at a local bar and charge \$10-15 excess per person to attend. Have a raffle or silent auction to raise additional funds.

Host a dinner party and ask those who attend to make a donation.

Have a garage sale and donate the proceeds.

Matching gifts—make sure you submit for the match if your employer matches donations. Follow up with those who donate to see if their employers match. This can double or even triple the donations!

Sell your used items on E-bay and donate the proceeds.

Host a bake sale and donate the proceeds.

Host a vendor party. Invite Mary Kay consultants, Pampered Chef consultants, LuLaRoe consultants, etc. and ask the consultants to donate some of the proceeds of the event.

Ask your employer to have a dress-down day. Employees can wear jeans if they make a \$5 donation.

Host a painting class. Companies will set up the private event with you and donate a portion of the class fee.

Think through everyone in your sphere of influence: civic clubs, health clubs, professional network, faith-based groups, chamber of commerce, the list goes on! Ask everyone!

Ask your company to sponsor the run/walk.

Ask a local business or restaurant to donate a portion of their proceeds for a certain product or a certain day.

Schedule a pub trivia night and get the proceeds donated.

ASK! Then ask again!
